Rules and Regulations

1. Exhibitors must be 50 years or over by Dec. 31, 2010.
2. The entry fee is \$10.00, payable at time of registration.
3. Exhibits must be brought to the Centennial Centre
 (4313 50 Ave) for display on either July 15th, from 5:00-
 7:00p.m. or July 16th, between 8:30 and 10:00 a.m.
4. All exhibits must be the work of the person exhibiting.
5. No exhibitor will be allowed more than two entries in any
 one class.
6. All articles presented must be fresh and clean, otherwise
 they will be disqualified.
7. Any provincial winning exhibit is ineligible for display.
8. Exhibits will be open for public viewing at 2:00 - 7:00 pm
 on July 16th and from 9:00 am-4:00 pm on July 17th.
 Pick up items after 4:00 pm.
9. All exhibitors are responsible for insuring their display.
10. The wines will be judged by a panel of judges.
11. Medals will be awarded at the Banquet.
12. Any exhibitor making entries agrees to be governed by the
 for-going rules.
